Director's Note

The 2 keys to successfully directing a play are: choosing a great play and casting it well. I think I have done both. Casting, in my mind, is more than 90% of the job of directing. This ensemble cast is one of the best casts I have ever had the pleasure of collaborating with!

You can't however skip the first step; namely choosing a great play. Tom Griffin wrote the Boys Next Door (TBND) in the late 1980's. In an interview once, Mr. Griffin said, "I write serious plays that are funny." TBND is a well-written, funny, poignant, heart-warming, and heart-breaking, important play. I think Tom Griffin would be greatly saddened, that over thirty years since his play had its world premiere, the problems that the play addresses, we as a society are still dealing with in our treatment of the mentally challenged.

TBND deals with the fundamental human rights of the mentally challenged. TBND is the story of four housemates living in a group home and the increasingly burned-out social worker who cares for them. Three of the housemates (Arnold, Lucien and Norman) are mentally challenged to varying degrees and the fourth (Barry) is schizophrenic. They ARE a family. They don't always get along or like each other, but they always love and care for each other.

The play is a series of vignettes that will have you laughing at one moment and crying tears of sadness and compassion the next. Hopefully you'll leave the theater with a new understanding of the plight of mentally challenged people in our society.

No spoilers here! I'll let the playwright tell the men's stories through our actors' performances.

"Hello, my name is Norman Bulansky. Welcome to my home. Won't you take a seat?"

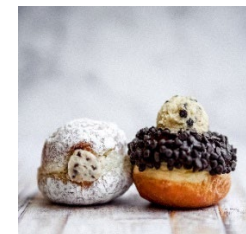
