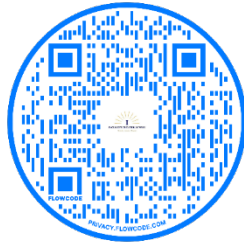


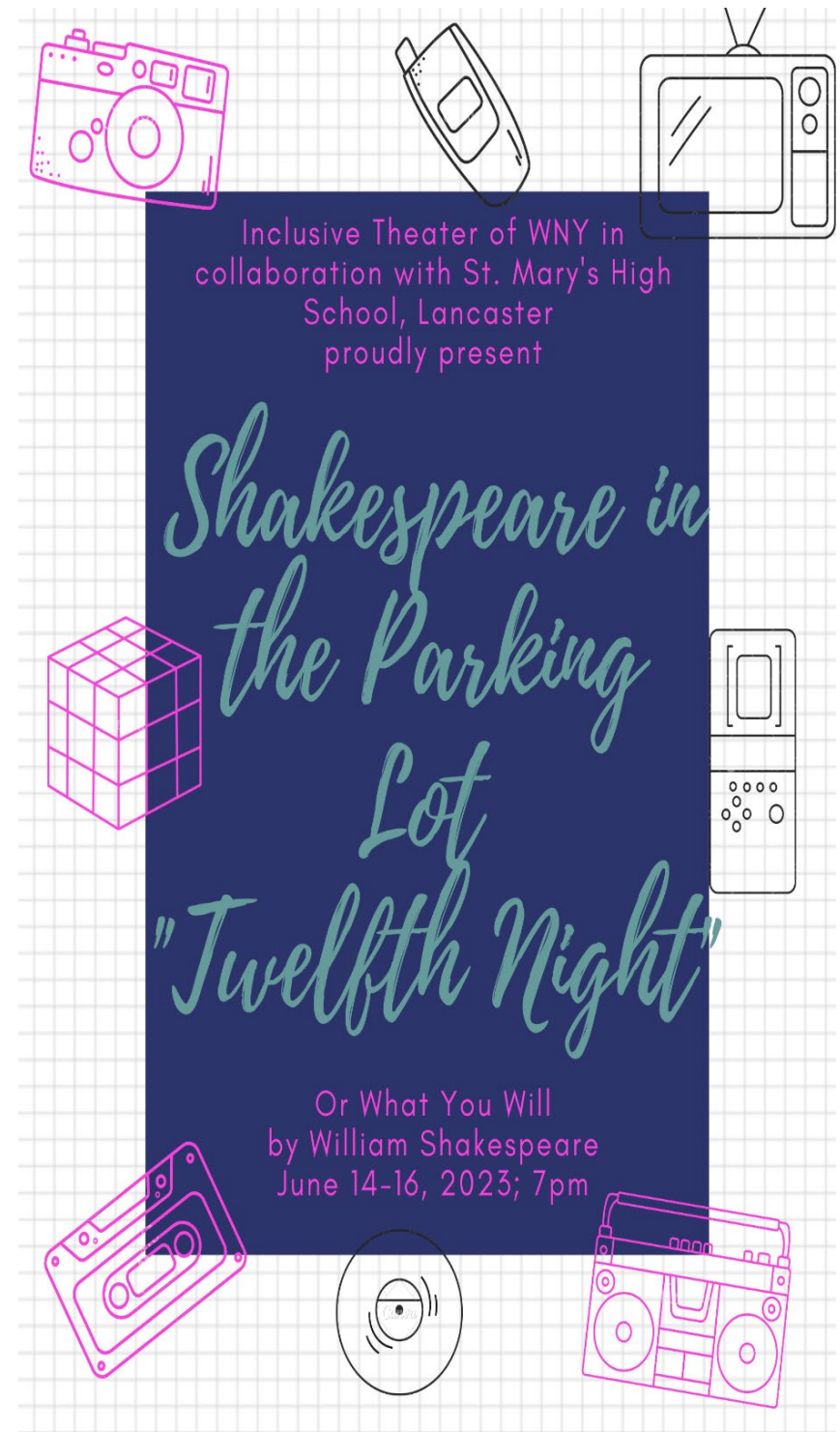

- Twelfth Night festivities were not your grandma's Christmas parties. They were hugely raucous and full of drinking and mischief-making.
- In Shakespeare's time, Viola's part, like all the parts in Twelfth Night, would have been played by a man, because women were not allowed to act professionally.
